Promote **Cooperation and** Teamwork



Research, Design, Build, Test, & Improve

Display curiosity and Show your own interest in learning

Watch STEM Programming

There are a lot of videos, movies, television shows out there that you and your child can watch together

Talk together about the program and see what STEM-activities you can duplicate or recreate.

Doing STEM does not have to be complicated or expensive

It is all about encouragement and influence that helps your child understand and be interested in STEM
